

How to Access your MyEDBC Student Portal or reset your MyEDBC Password

1. Go to the www.doverbay.ca website.
2. Click on the home tab and then the MyEDBC link under Quick Links on the left hand side of the screen. (Do not google MyEd as you will not get the correct login screen.)
3. Type in your Login ID which is always **s68.your student number**. (ie. S68.123456)
4. Click on the blue "I forgot my password" link. An email containing your login id and a temporary password will be sent to the email address that you have linked to your account.
5. If you do not know the email address linked to your account, please come to office and ask for Mrs. Knappett.
6. Enter the temporary password that was emailed to you and click on the LOG ON button. A box will pop up with a red x in it. Click OK and follow the directions to reset your password.
